

# Electromechanical and Manufacturing Engineering

## Specific Requirements for Direct Application

In addition to the general requirements for the application to the International Undergraduate Program, applicants who want to enroll in the Electromechanical and Manufacturing Engineering Program must demonstrate all of the following additional proficiencies:

### 1. English Language Proficiency

Applicants must demonstrate their English proficiency through one of the following methods:

#### ○ Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Score

Applicants must score no less than the listed scores in one of the following TOEFL test methods:

- TOEFL Paper-based test (pBT): 500
- TOEFL Computer-based test (cBT): 173
- TOEFL Internet-based test (iBT): 81

#### ○ International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Score

Applicant must score no less than 5.5 on the IELTS test.

#### ○ Commissioner of Higher Education Score

Applicant must score—on the Commissioner's A-Net test—no less than 65 on the English subject. Score from previous testing system is also applicable (no less than 65)

#### ○ English Language Test.

Applicants must score higher than 60%.

### 2. Academic Proficiency

Applicants must demonstrate their academic proficiency through one of the following methods:

#### ○ SAT® Score

Applicant must score no less than 1,000 (with Math's score of at least 600) on the SAT® test.

#### ○ Engineering Subject Test.

Applicants must score higher than 60%.
